



# ROWINGTON ALLOTMENTS CONSTITUTION

## 1. NAME

The Association shall be known as Rowington Allotments Association

## 2. OBJECTIVE

The objectives of the society shall be:

- Together with Rowington Parish Council manage and supervise the Allotments for the benefit of the members.
- To ensure the continued cultivation of the 8 allotment plots situated at Queens Drive Rowington.

## 4. COMPLIANCE

The society shall be administered jointly by Rowington Parish Council, the land tenant and Rowington Allotment Association the sub tenant.

The society shall abide by the rules of Rowington Allotments Association as agreed by a majority of its members

## 3. MEMBERSHIP & FEES

Membership of the Association shall be all plot holders within Rowington Allotments situated at Queens Drive, whether cultivating a whole or half a plot. Each plot (whether a whole or half a plot) will be considered to have one vote in any decision making.

Membership fees will run from January 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup>. and will be collected by no later than the end of March in any one calendar year.

## 5. MEETINGS

The Association will hold 4 meetings a year one of which will be the AGM.

- **Voting:** All votes will be decided by a simple majority of the members present. In the event of a split decision the chairman will have the casting vote.
- **Quorum:** The quorum for meetings will be 5 members.

## 6. COMMITTEE

A Chairman and Secretary will hold office for 3 years.

## 7. FINANCE

All monies raised by the association shall first be allocated to the land rental, any further monies raised will be used solely to further the objectives of the Association.

## 8. ALTERATIONS

Proposals to alter this Constitution can only be made as Resolutions at an Annual General Meeting of the Association. Alterations will be made as a result of resolutions passed by a simple majority of members present.
